The Missouri Forest Products Association (MFPA) announces the Professional Timber Harvester Program, Levels I and II. The Level I session, will begin with emphasis on the importance of protective equipment, parts of a saw, their purpose and proper sharpening techniques. Participants will learn the benefits of controlled felling and bow cutting. The Level II session will be devoted to learning the use of felling, wedges, collecting data on hazards, tree height, lean, and planned escape routes. Each participant will fell a tree. Level I and II will be held in Winona, MO on October 3 & 4 and in Macon, MO on Oct 17 & 18. These sessions will be taught by Joe Glenn, a foremost trainer and woodsman.
