TIMBER FOR SALE

The Missouri Department of Conservation intends to sell forest products to companies and/or entities that have proper training. Accordingly, the Missouri Department of Conservation will only accept and enter into contracts in which the individual who is designated to sign timber sale contracts <u>and</u> the individual responsible for supervision of the logging have both successfully completed training, and maintained certification, pursuant to the MFPA Professional Timber Harvester Training, or its approved equivalent. Missouri Department of Conservation forest land is certified to the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) program and supports program objectives."

The Missouri Department of Conservation will accept bids on a salvage timber sale located in Chilton Creek. The sale contains mixed hardwood and pine sawtimber on approximately 254 acres. The forest products are in Shannon County and Carter County Missouri: Township 28 North, Range 01 West, Sections 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 27, 28, and 29.

A tour of the area will be conducted on January 14, 2025, at 9 a.m. The tour will start from the Pin Oak River Access, located off M Highway, at the following coordinates: 37° 03' 59" N, 91° 02' 42" W. Prospective bidders or their representative MUST attend the tour to obtain a bid form. Attendees will only represent one bidder.
