
MISSOURI LOGGING COUNCIL BYLAWS

Adopted August 2008

ARTICLE I – NAME

The Name of the organization shall be the Missouri Logging Council.

ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the Council shall be Jefferson City.

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

The purpose of this Council shall be:

To improve and expand the use of professional logging and trucking practices responsive to the needs of customers, employees, landowners, and the general public; To provide educational training for members within the logging and hauling profession; and To improve upon worker safety.

ARTICLE IV – MEMBERSHIP

Council members consist of all Missouri Forest Products Association (MFPA) members who are engaged in harvesting and/or hauling forest products. There will be two (2) categories of membership:

LOGGER MEMBER

Logging contractor and/or forest product hauling contractor.

PROFESSIONAL LOGGER

Employee of a logging and/or hauling contractor.

ARTICLE V – ORGANIZATION

Chapters may be formed where there are ten (10) or more eligible MFPA members: upon approval of the MFPA board of directors.

ARTICLE VI – OFFICERS

The State Chairman and Vice Chairman will be elected by the Council Board of Directors subject to confirmation of the MFPA Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VII – MEETINGS

The Chairman and the Board of Directors will meet a minimum of once each year. Other meeting times and locations will be at the call of the Chairman. Chapters will meet twice yearly for the purpose of electing leadership and conducting other business items in conjunction with the purpose of the Council.

ARTICLE VIX – VOTING

Professional logger members will be NON-voting members. The Council will be governed by a Board of Directors, consisting of up to six Directors. The Directors will be selected from the voting membership of the Council.
