You are invited to bid on the privately-owned timber as described:

<u>PROPERTY:</u> The timber discussed herein is the property of **Doug Smith**. The sale area is approximately **34** acres, owned by the Seller, in Section 7 of Township 45 N, Range 24 W, Johnson County, MO. See **Figure 2** for more location information.

<u>DESCRIPTION:</u> An estimated **15,647 board feet (Doyle)** of primarily oak sawtimber, including the species listed in the Timber Bid Form below, has been marked for cutting by a Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) forester. The estimated volumes by diameter and species are shown in **Table 1**. Accuracy of estimates is not guaranteed. The tree count by diameter and species are shown in **Table 2**. The decision and amount to bid should be based on prospective bidders' or their representatives' own examination of the sale site by tour.

Trees to be sold and cut are marked with red paint roughly 4.5 feet above the ground, accompanied by a corresponding paint spot on the stump. A minimum of 80% of trees marked with red paint MUST be felled. Trees marked with an "X" were deemed to have uncertain profitability and were not included in the estimated total volume. However, these trees MUST be felled and may be left or taken for profit at the Buyer's discretion.

<u>BID INSTRUCTIONS:</u> Bid must be received before 11:00 AM CST on Feb. 03, 2025. Only legible bids will be accepted. Late, verbal, or telephone bids will not be accepted. Falsification of any part of this bid solicitation will result in the rejection of the bid. All bids are final.

If emailed, type "SMITH TIMBER BID" in the Subject line of the email with your attached bid or reply directly to the bid solicitation email. A response of "no bid" is also acceptable if you choose not to issue a bid. Bids received by email will be acknowledged. There will be no acknowledgment of bids received by mail.

The contract will be awarded at the decision of the landowner. MDC uses a scoring system that awards points to each bidder based on four evaluation categories, with more points going to bidders that offer a higher bid, are PTH or Master Loggers, have PTH trained loggers on their crew, or have been awarded MDC Logger of the Year. The results of the scoring are then provided to the landowner to make the final decision. The highest lump sum bid may or may not be awarded the contract.

Please fill out the categories below. Any category with missing information will receive a score of zero points. The landowner has the right to reject any and all bids regardless of points awarded or price offered. Bids will be opened and reviewed at 11:00AM CST on Feb. 03, 2025.

The contract will be awarded within five (5) business days AFTER review. The contract is to be signed within fourteen (14) business days AFTER the award of contract. The contract recipient will be required to pay for the timber as described in the Timber Sale Contract. The awardee will have twelve (12) months from contract signing to cut and remove the timber in accordance with the contract. Contract extensions may be granted due to weather and other factors. All payments shall be made out in the name of the landowner (i.e., Seller). Because a portion of the haul road utilizes the edge of a cropped field, all hauling operations must occur prior to spring planting or following harvest, unless an alternate haul route can be agreed upon.

A performance bond in the amount of 5% of the total lump sum bid will be required at contract signing. The performance bond shall be in the form of a cashier's check made out in the landowner's name. The performance bond will be held in security by the landowner until the terms of the Timber Sale Contract have been satisfied, at which point the landowner will return the performance bond (check) to the contractor. The performance bond must be current for the entire length of the contract, including any extensions.

Neither the Missouri Department of Conservation, nor any of its employees, is acting as a legal agent for the owner.


